助理署長(更生事務)陳碩聖(前排中)及更生事務科的高級官員。 Mr Samson Chan, Assistant Commissioner (Rehabilitation) (centre in the front row) and senior officers of the Rehabilitation Division. 羈押罪犯的最終目的,是協助他們重新融入社會成為守法公民。更生事務科於一九九八年成立,專責於這方面的工作。本人在二零零三年獲委任為該科的主管,感到欣幸。

二零零三年,更生事務科繼續增強針對不同罪犯更生需要的服務。我們為所有青少年罪犯制定計劃,減少他們重犯的風險。去年十一月,更在勵新懲教所推行試驗計劃,為21至25歲的男犯安排獲釋前的全日制職業訓練,增加他們獲釋後的就業機會。

The ultimate aim of detention of offenders is to prepare them for re-integration into society as law-abiding citizens. The Rehabilitation Division was set up in 1998 specifically for this important area of work and I am delighted to be appointed head of the Division in May 2003.

In 2003, the Division continued to enhance its services to address the rehabilitative needs of different types of offenders. We developed the Offending Behaviour Programme for all young offenders to reduce their risk of re-offending. In November, a pilot scheme was launched at Lai Sun Correctional Institution to increase the employment potential of male prisoners aged 21 to 25 by engaging them in full-time vocational training prior to release.

我們在二零零三年十月委託香港大學進行一個兩年的研究項目,為有濫用精神藥物問題的罪犯制定預防和治療計劃。此外,亦正考慮借助具備學識專長的在囚和志願人士協助囚犯修習學術/文化課程。

參照社區參與助更生委員會的建議,本署在年內推行一系列宣傳活動,對象是 4個社區組別,即學生、僱主、地區組織和市民大眾。除了分區撲滅罪行委員會外,亦邀請非政府機構和志願團體聯手舉辦這些活動。為配合 2003-04 年度的「健康生活」宣傳主題,我們委任 4 位頂尖運動員一方力申、李致和、黃金寶和趙詠賢,以及影藝名人許志安出任更生大使,協助宣傳信息。

愈來愈多的社區組織認為,更生人士如能 成功改過,整個社會將會受惠。部分社區 組織透過我們的宣傳活動得知更生人士的 需要和重返社會的努力後,表示有意給予 支持,這是令人鼓舞的。更生事務科所有 人員會繼續上述推廣工作,在未來數年建 立更廣闊的社會支緩網絡以提供協助。

判前評估服務

判處罪犯恰當刑期和派往切合他們更生需要的懲敎院所,對更生計劃成功與否起極大作用。本署就犯人是否適合判入個別更生計劃向法庭提供判前評估服務。一名判前評估專責小組人員會與還押犯會面,並從其家庭、學校、僱主等取得背景資料,協助本署轄下的評估委員會擬就一份全面的評估報告,讓法庭審議。年內,本署共向法庭提交5 455 份判前評估報告。

青少年罪犯評估專案小組

此專案小組由本署及社會福利署專業人員組成。裁判官或法官可把 14 至 24 歲的年輕男犯及 14 至 20 歲的年輕女犯的個案轉介予小組,由小組綜合意見後擬定最適合他們的更生計劃。年內,專案小組共接獲390 宗由法庭轉介的個案,而小組的建議有85.3%獲得接納。

福利服務

本署有囚犯福利主任協助及指導囚犯解決因監禁而引起的個人問題及困難。他們亦統籌由非政府組織向罪犯提供的志願服務。年內,囚犯福利主任除進行了143060次個別輔導外,亦舉辦了1066次小組輔導,2195個重新融入社會釋前啟導課程及協助囚犯在獲釋時順利重返社



We commissioned the University of Hong Kong in October 2003 for a two-year project to develop preventive and treatment programmes for offenders with problems of psychotropic substance abuse. A plan was also under consideration to employ offenders and volunteers with special skills to help persons under custody in their educational/cultural pursuits.

With the advice of the Committee on Community Support for Rehabilitated Offenders, we launched a series of publicity activities targeting four community groups, namely students, employers, district groups and the general public in the year. In addition to District Fight Crime Committees, non-government organisations and voluntary agencies were invited to join us in organising these activities. To tie in with the 2003-04 publicity theme, Healthy Life, four leading athletes - Mr Alex Fong, Mr Lee Chi-wo, Mr Wong Kam-po and Ms Rebecca Chiu - and famous artiste, Mr Andy Hui, have been appointed Rehabilitation Ambassadors to help convey the publicity message.

An increasing number of community groups share the view that the community as a whole would benefit from the successful transition of rehabilitated offenders. It is encouraging that some have expressed interest in rendering support to them after learning their needs and rehabilitation efforts through our publicity activities. All members of the Division will sustain these promotional efforts with a view to building a wider community supportive network for rehabilitated offenders in the coming years.

Pre-sentence Assessment Services

Much of the success of rehabilitation programmes depends on giving offenders an appropriate sentence and placement that can best meet their rehabilitation needs. Pre-sentence assessment services are provided for the courts regarding an offender's suitability of being sentenced to a particular rehabilitation programme. The Pre-sentence Assessment Panel Officer, after interviewing the offender under remand and obtaining background information from family, school, employers, etc., assists the Assessment Board of the Department in compiling a comprehensive assessment report for the court's consideration. In 2003, 5 455 pre-sentence assessment reports were provided to the courts.

Young Offender Assessment Panel

Magistrates or judges may also refer cases to the Young Offender Assessment Panel, which comprises professional staff from the Department and the Social Welfare Department, for a co-ordinated view on the most appropriate rehabilitation programme for convicted young male offenders aged 14 to 24 and female offenders aged 14 to 20. In 2003, the Panel received 390 referrals from the courts and 85.3% of its recommendations were accepted.

Welfare Services

Prisoners' Welfare Officers (PWOs) provide assistance and guidance to prisoners in handling personal problems and difficulties arising from imprisonment. They also co-ordinate voluntary services rendered by the non-government organisations to offenders. Apart from conducting 143 060

心理服務

本署的臨床心理學家及曾接受心理輔導 訓練的職員為所有囚犯及所員提供心理 服務,目的是改變其犯罪行為和促進心 理健康。年內,心理服務組為囚犯共進 行28 774次輔導晤談,並合共擬備369份 評估報告,協助法庭及各有關的覆檢委員 會就罪犯更生作出決定。

為減少再犯案率,年內積極發展和調整心 理輔導計劃,以針對犯罪行為。有關計劃 包括年輕罪犯心理更生課程,用以緩減他 們的犯罪思想和態度; 親子計劃, 用以改 進青少年罪犯與家庭的溝通技巧; 關注濫 用藥物及預防重犯計劃,特為有濫用藥物 背景的成年囚犯而設;心理治療計劃,專

為在戒毒所接受治療的所員而推行; 為性 罪犯關設的性罪犯心理評估治療組;以及 為成人暴力罪犯而設的預防暴力輔導計 劃。

徽敎敎育

教育組向不足21歲的年輕囚犯推行半日制 強制教育課程,並為自願接受教育的成年 囚犯提供指導。為增強語文和電腦教育, 本署在二零零三年三月於東頭懲敎所設立 多媒體學習中心。同類設施已在石壁監 獄、白沙灣徽教所和所有青少年罪犯院所提 供。

年內,囚犯在各公開考試共報考1 211 卷,整體合格率為64.4%,詳情見附錄 8。截至二零零三年十二月三十一日止,共 有 101 名囚犯報讀由香港公開大學及亞洲 (澳門)國際公開大學舉辦的學位、文憑或證 書遙距課程。有需要的囚犯可向在囚人士 教育信託基金申請撥款資助。

職業訓練

年齡不足21歲的年輕囚犯須接受半日制強 制性的工商業技能訓練,目的是協助他們 獲釋後順利重返社會。署方開辦各類配合 社會發展的課程,使年輕囚犯能通過英國 倫敦城市行業協會考試或必文學會考試, 考取認可資格。部分課程可協助他們做好

individual counselling sessions in 2003, PWOs organised 1 066 group counselling sessions, 2 195 Pre-release Reintegration Orientation Courses in the year to help prisoners reintegrate smoothly into society upon release. Through these activities, prisoners are provided with information about the labour market and community resources such as social welfare, and training in job-interview techniques and social interaction skills.

Psychological Services

A team of clinical psychologists and departmental officers trained in psychological work help inmates and prisoners change their offending behaviour and promote their psychological well-being. In 2003, 28 774 counselling sessions were conducted, and 369 assessment reports were prepared for the courts and related review boards for making decisions on the rehabilitation of offenders.

To reduce recidivism, efforts were made in the year to develop and refine the psychological programmes targeting offending behaviour. The programmes include the Offending Behaviour Programme for young offenders to reduce their criminal thinking and attitude, the Inmate-Parent Programme to improve communication skills of young offenders and their families, the Substance Abuse Awareness and Recidivism Prevention Programme for adult offenders with a history of chronic substance abuse, and psychological treatment programmes for inmates receiving treatment at Drug Addiction Treatment Centres and the Sex Offender Evaluation and Treatment Unit. and Violence Prevention Programme for adult offenders.

Correctional Education

The Education Unit provides half-day compulsory education programmes for young offenders under the age of 2I and quidance to adult offenders who voluntarily participate in educational studies. To enhance language and computer education, a multi-media learning centre was set up in Tung Tau Correctional Institution in March 2003. Similar facilities have already been provided in Shek Pik Prison, Pak Sha Wan Correctional Institution and all young offenders' institutions. In 2003, inmates and prisoners attempted a total of 1 211 public examination papers and the overall passing rate was 64%. Details are shown in Appendix 8. As at December 31, 2003, 101 prisoners enrolled in distance learning courses at degree, diploma or certificate level run by the Open University of Hong Kong and the Asia International Open University of Macau. Prisoners may apply for financial assistance for

準備,以參加職業訓練局、建造業訓練 局、製衣業訓練局、香港考試及評核局的 工藝測試或考試。

成年囚犯須參與工業生產,並接受所需技 能訓練。他們可參加建造業訓練局的中級 工藝測試和建造工程雜工班,以取得職業 技能認可資格。

「青年自我增值」試驗計劃在二零零三年十 一月開始推行,讓參加計劃的21歲以上至 25 歲以下在囚人士接受全日制職業訓練課 程。參加是項計劃純屬自願性質,參加者 最少應有初中教育程度,刑期尚餘6至18 個月。截至二零零三年十二月三十一日為 止,共有10名囚犯/所員參加是項計劃。

年內, 囚犯參加的公開考試及工藝測試共

計692卷,整體及格率為91%。當中分別 有116名及62名囚犯在建造業訓練局及職 業訓練局的中級工藝測試取得及格。各項 考試的成績詳見附錄9。

善後輔導服務

署方對年輕的監獄囚犯、勞敎中心、更生 中心、教導所及戒毒所釋放的所員,以及 根據各種監管計劃釋放的囚犯進行法定善 後監管。這項服務是懲教及更生計劃的重 要環節,目的是幫助囚犯獲釋後安分守己, 奉公守法。

為達致有效監管,善後輔導組人員在犯人 羈留期間努力與囚犯及其家人/有影響力的 親友建立互信關係,他們亦向受監管的囚 犯提供適當支援和指引,使其適應懲教程 序和面對將遇到的困難。透過定期接觸和 探訪,善後輔導組人員協助獲釋的囚犯重 過奉公守法的生活。倘受監管人違反監管 條件,可被召回懲敎院所囚禁。年內,本 署共發出677道召回令。

監管計劃

根據「監管試釋計劃」和「釋前就業計劃」 的規定,申請獲批准者可提早出獄,並接 受善後監管,或在設有善後輔導服務的宿 舍居住,但可出外工作。上述計劃的目

months. As at December 31, 2003, 10 inmates had enrolled in the programme.

Vocational Training

Young offenders under the age of 21 receive half-day compulsory technical and commercial training to facilitate their reintegration into society after discharge. Courses keeping pace with developments of the community are conducted to help inmates obtain accredited qualifications of the City and Guilds International or the Pitman Qualifications. Training is also provided to prepare inmates for trade tests or examinations conducted by the Vocational Training Council (VTC), the Construction Industry Training Authority (CITA), the Clothing Industry Training Authority and the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority.

Adult prisoners are engaged in industrial production and trained to acquire the necessary skills. Opportunities for skill accreditation are provided through participation in the Construction Labourer (General) Course and the Intermediate Trade Tests conducted by the CITA.

The pilot Enhanced Reintegration Programme for male prisoners aged over 21 and under 25 to receive full-time vocational training was introduced in November 2003. Participation in this programme is strictly voluntary. The applicants should attain at least junior secondary educational level and have a balance of sentence between six and 18 In 2003, inmates and prisoners took 692 public examination papers and trade tests, and the overall passing rate was 91%. Among them, 116 and 62 passed the Intermediate Trade Tests conducted by the CITA and the VTC respectively. Details of the examination results are shown in Appendix 9.

Aftercare Services

Statutory aftercare supervision is provided for young prisoners, persons released from detention, rehabilitation, training and drug addiction treatment centres, and prisoners released under various supervision schemes. The service is an integral part of the correctional and rehabilitation programmes to assist offenders in reintegrating into society smoothly and leading a decent and law-abiding life upon release.

To prepare for effective supervision, aftercare officers strive to foster a relationship of mutual trust with inmates as well as their families/significant others while the inmates are under custody. They also give inmates appropriate support and guidance to help them adapt to the institutional programme and become aware of their inadequacies and the difficulties ahead. Through regular contacts and visits, inmates discharged under supervision are assisted in leading a lawabiding and decent life. A breach of the supervision conditions may result in the supervisee being recalled to an institution 的,是鼓勵符合資格、合適及決心改過的 囚犯在監管下,在開放的環境繼續服刑。 「監管試釋計劃」為特定類別的成年囚犯提 供善後監管,以協助他們改過自新,重投 社會。違反監管條件者得被召回懲敎院 所,在餘下的監管期繼續服刑。

根據有條件釋放計劃的規定,不定期徒刑 的囚犯可在長期監禁刑罰覆核委員會就應 否將其刑罰轉為確定限期刑罰作出建議 前,獲准在指明監管期的情況下有條件釋 放,以考驗他們是否有決心及有能力奉公 守法。 長期監禁刑罰覆核委員會亦可發出 命令,安排刑罰由不定期轉為定期的囚犯 根據釋後監管計劃的規定接受釋後監管。

截至二零零三年十二月三十一日止,仍接 受善後監管者共有2907人。個案分類資 料及成功率統計載於附錄 10。

中途宿舍計劃

中途宿舍計劃是勞敎中心、敎導所、戒毒 所及監獄所提供的更生服務的延展。在獲 釋後需要一段過渡期適應的受監管者會入 住中途宿舍。他們於日間出外工作或上

學,夜間則返回宿舍。本署目前管理3間 中途宿舍,包括豐力樓、百勤樓和紫荊樓。

該計劃旨在讓宿員在井井有條的環境及有 實質支持的情況下,培養自律精神和良好 工作習慣。計劃着重他們的行為表現、人 際關係和家人支持。除個別及小組輔導 外,宿舍亦舉辦康樂活動、戶外活動及社 區服務,藉以培養宿員的公民意識及道德 觀念。在周末及公眾假期,宿員通常會獲 准外宿,以便融入社會。

年內,共有359名釋囚入住上述3間中途宿 舍。

宗敎服務

懲敎院所提供的宗敎服務由一名全職的懲敎 署司鐸及其助手策劃,另有多名義務司鐸協 助。他們會到訪懲敎院所,為囚犯提供服 務。凡自願參與的囚犯,不論其宗教信仰為 何,均可獲得該類服務。服務範圍包括探 訪、教學、輔導、宗教崇拜及康樂活動。

for further training. In 2003, 677 recall orders were issued.

Supervision Schemes for Prisoners

Under the Release Under Supervision Scheme and the Prerelease Employment Scheme, successful applicants may be discharged from prison before the end of their imprisonment for aftercare supervision or permitted to go out to work and live in a hostel with aftercare services. Both schemes are aimed at giving an opportunity for suitable, eligible and motivated prisoners to serve their sentences in an open environment with supervision.

The Post-Release Supervision of Prisoners Scheme provides aftercare supervision for certain categories of adult prisoners to facilitate their rehabilitation and reintegration into society. Prisoners breaching the supervision conditions may be recalled to serve the balance of their unexpired supervision period.

Under the Conditional Release Scheme, prisoners with indeterminate sentences may, before the Long-term Prison Sentences Review Board makes recommendations as to whether their indeterminate sentences should be converted to determinate ones, be conditionally released under supervision for a specific period to test their determination and ability to lead a law-abiding life. Prisoners with indeterminate sentences having been converted to determinate ones may also be ordered by the Board to be placed under post-release supervision under the Supervision After Release Scheme.

As at December 31, 2003, a total of 2 907 persons were under

active aftercare supervision. A breakdown of the caseload and statistics on success rates are in Appendix 10.

Half-way House Programme

The Half-way House Programme is an extension of the rehabilitative efforts sustained in detention centre, training centres, drug addiction treatment centres or prisons. Following release, supervisees in need of a period of transitional adjustment reside in a half-way house from which they go out to work or school during daytime and to which they return at night. There are three half-way houses run by the Department, namely Phoenix House, Pelican House and Bauhinia House.

The programme seeks to cultivate a sense of self-discipline and good working habits in a structured and supportive environment. Emphasis is placed on behavioural performance, inter-personal relationship and family support. Individual and group counselling sessions, in-house recreation and outdoor activities and community services are organised to strengthen residents' civic and moral awareness. Leave of absence is generally granted on weekends and public holidays to facilitate social reintegration. In 2003, a total of 359 residents were admitted to the three half-way houses.

Religious Services

A full-time Correctional Services Chaplain and his assistant co-ordinate the planning and provision of religious services. They are assisted by a number of honorary chaplains who visit and conduct services on a voluntary basis. All inmates can participate in the religious services offered voluntarily

非政府機構

我們與非政府機構緊密合作,為所員和囚 犯提供福利服務。年內,24個非政府機構 的 403 名義工積極參與各項服務,範圍包 括個別輔導和宗教服務,以至籌辦大型文 化和康樂計劃。得到他們的支持,不少顯 露囚犯才能的比賽得以舉辦,包括海報設 計比賽、漫畫創作比賽和院所樂隊比賽, 均有助增強參與的所員的自信,爭取市民 支持本署的更生工作。

社區參與爭取社會支持

社會的接納和支持對囚犯更生及重投社會 至為重要。成員來自不同界別,包括社區 領袖、僱主、教育工作者、專業人士、非 政府機構和政府部門代表的社區參與助更 生委員會,就更生計劃、重新融入社會和 宣傳策略提出意見。委員會的職責範圍及 成員名單見附錄 11。

宣傳活動

為協助市民了解更生人士的需要和面對的 困難,並給予協助,本署自一九九九年以 來展開連串宣傳活動。二零零三年舉辦的 主要活動詳情均載列於附錄12,包括:與 18 區撲滅罪行委員會舉辦的社區參與活 動; 由教導所所員擔綱的「童軍樂韻獻社 群」之「才華共顯樂融融」音樂匯演; 「人生交叉點 | 青少年學生座談會 — 同類 的青少年座談會將於多個地區陸續舉行;

regardless of their religious affiliation. These include visits, teaching, counselling, religious worship and recreational activities.

Non-Government Organisations

We work closely with non-government organisations for the welfare of inmates and prisoners. In 2003, 403 volunteers from 24 non-government organisations actively involved in a variety of services ranging from individual counselling and religious services to the organisation of large-scale cultural and recreational projects. With their support, a number of competitions to display the talents of persons under custody were held. These include the Poster Design Competition, Creative Drawing Competition and Inter-institutional Band Contest, which helped boost the confidence of the inmate participants and solicit community support for the Department's rehabilitation work.

Reaching Out to the Community

Community acceptance and support is of paramount importance to the rehabilitation of offenders and their reintegration into society. Comprising community leaders, employers, education workers, professionals and representatives of non-government organisations and government departments, the Committee on Community Support for Rehabilitated Offenders advises the Commissioner on rehabilitation programmes, and re-integration and publicity strategies. The terms of reference and membership of the Committee are in Appendix 11.

Publicity Activities

To help the community better understand the needs and problems of rehabilitated offenders and to appeal for public support, the Department has launched a series of publicity activities since 1999. Details of major activities in 2003,

面晤囚犯計劃

本署舉辦面晤囚犯計劃,作為滅罪運動 的一環。少年及學童獲安排參觀指定懲 教院所其中一間,與改過自新的囚犯面 談和交流,讓他們了解犯罪的後果,以 收防止青少年犯罪之效。該計劃推行以 來反應良好。年內參加的青少年及學童 共達 2 268 人。

綠島計劃

本署在二零零一年一月推出綠島計劃,向 青少年宣傳禁毒信息及保護環境的重要 性。參加者與喜靈洲戒毒所的青少年所員 會面,了解濫用藥物的禍害,並參觀喜靈 洲島上現時的環保設施。他們亦會進行植 樹儀式,以示支持環保及更生人士,同持 亦宣誓決志遠離毒品。年內,本署共安排 了24次參觀活動,有601人參加。

including joint community involvement activities with the 18 District Fight Crime Committees, a musical performance highlighting the achievement and significance of scouting and guiding activities of the Training Centre inmates, a joint school student forum marking the start of similar forums in various districts, and the production and distribution of a VCD on the second series of the TV docu-drama The Road Back, are at Appendix 12.

Personal Encounter with Prisoners Scheme

The Department runs the Personal Encounter with Prisoners Scheme as part of the community's fight crime campaign. Young people and students visit one of the several designated institutions to meet with reformed prisoners in experience sharing sessions. The purpose is to help prevent delinquency through the deepening of participants' understanding of the consequences of committing a crime. A total of 2 268 young people and students visited the institutions under the scheme in 2003.

Green Haven Scheme

The Department started the Green Haven Scheme in January 2001 to promote the anti-drug message and the importance of environmental protection among young people. Participants meet with young inmates of Hei Ling Chau Addiction Treatment Centre to gain insight into the detrimental effects of drug abuse. They also take part in a tree planting ceremony to indicate their support for rehabilitated offenders and environmental protection, and vow to stay away from drugs. During the year, 24 visits were arranged for a total of 601 participants.
