Question:

In respect of Targets and Matters Requiring Special Attention, it is stated that the Department will revitalise the aged correctional facilities. What facilities are involved? Has the Department set the priorities for revitalisation of these facilities?

Asked by: Dr Hon LAU Wong-fat (Member Question No. 19)

Reply:

At the end of 2015, of the 29 correctional facilities in operation, 13 have been in operation for 40 years or above. The Correctional Services Department (CSD) has been adopting different measures to improve and replace the ageing facilities. In terms of short-term measures, CSD regularly inspects, maintains and repairs the relevant facilities. In terms of long-term measures, CSD plans and implements improvement and redevelopment (including partial redevelopment) projects of correctional institutions, having regard to actual needs.

The number of years of operation of the above 29 correctional facilities as well as the timetable of the major improvement/redevelopment projects under the Capital Works Reserve Fund and the project estimates are set out at Annex.
