As at 31 December 2015, 1,525 PICs of other nationalities came from 65 countries. Over 60% of them were from Asia (including Vietnam, Indonesia, Pakistan etc). The remaining PICs were from Africa and other regions.

The Correctional Services Department (CSD) has put in place appropriate measures, including but not limited to, organizing a number of non-Chinese language classes for CSD officers to facilitate management of PICs of other nationalities. The actual expenditure for such classes between 2011 and 2015 is set out below: -

In addition, consuls from various consular offices are invited to deliver cultural talks to CSD staff to better equip them with the knowledge on the culture and customs of PICs from other nationalities. Lectures on the awareness of the principles of human rights and equal opportunities respectively prescribed in the Hong Kong Bill of Rights Ordinance (Cap 383) and the Race Discrimination Ordinance (Cap 602) have also been incorporated into various staff training programmes. These talks and lectures did not incur additional cost.
